Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1), Defendants Arizona Board of Regents, Ron Shoopman, Larry Penley, Ram Krishna, Bill Ridenour, Lyndel Manson, Karrin Taylor Robson, Jay Heiler, and Fred DuVal (collectively, "Answering Defendants") object to the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation, (Doc. 46), on the grounds that it is not clear from the Report and Recommendation whether the Magistrate Judge's recommended dismissal of the Title VII claim applies to all parties.
